Competition in this Section is restricted to animals registered in a Herd Book recognised by the Dairy Goat Society of Australia Ltd.

(This means Saanens, Toggenburgs, British Alpines, Anglo Nubians, Australian Melaan and Australian Brown).

- All first lactation Does to be presented in the Judging ring at the beginning of Class 1, to be judged in milk then milked out. Does not entered in Best Udder to leave the ring.
- All second and subsequent Does to be presented in the Judging ring at the beginning of Class 2, to be judged in milk then milked out. Does not entered in Best Udder to leave the ring.

#### DEFINITIONS

A **Kid** is an unkidged Doe under 12 months at the date of the Show

A **Goatling** is an unkidged Doe between 12 & 24 months at the date of the Show.

## REGULATIONS

1. All goats over the age of twelve months must be CAE & Johne's disease negative; Kids to be from negative testing Does. Copies of veterinary certificates (within 12 months) must accompany entries & to be available on request on the day of the show.
2. ENTRY FEES AND MILK FIGURES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES.
3. Classes marked \* are special Classes for goats which must be shown in their appropriate age Classes
4. Classes may be divided or amalgamated according to the entry numbers
5. All ages at date of Show
6. Type & Production points to be stated on Entry Form & cards produced on the day if requested
7. Tattoos may be inspected by Stewards at any time. Pets need not be tattooed but must be blood tested and owners require a PIC.
8. Best Exhibit is judged from the Champion Milking Does, Champion Goatling & Champion Kid
9. All handlers to wear WHITE dust coats or shirts please.
