### Exhibitors Please Note:

**Location:** Exhibitors are to enter the showgrounds via MAIN GATE and immediately turn left and proceed in a clockwise direction around the Sheep Shed (see map). Stud Sheep – Shortwools are to be unloaded at the north end of the building and Stud Sheep – Longwools are to be unloaded at the south end.

All Black & Coloured Sheep are to unloaded at the North end of the shed. All sheep parking (see map located on page 49).

**Championship Sashes:** Champion and Reserve Champion sashes will be awarded in each Stud Sheep class. Champion sashes will only be awarded in the Black & Coloured Sheep. Where there is only one animal in a class the decision to award a Championship sash will be at the discretion of the judge.

**Most Successful Exhibitor:** The L.C. Gamble Perpetual Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the Exhibitor who obtains the highest aggregate of points in the Stud Sheep Sections. The Louise & Rodney Reeve Perpetual Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the Exhibitor who obtains the highest aggregate of points in the Black & Coloured Sheep Sections.

**Penning:** Any Stud Sheep Exhibitor wanting to pen their sheep on the Friday night prior to the Show can do so by contacting Sheep Superintendent: Mike Vallenge (Ph: 0403 292 662 or (03) 9560 1621)

**Fleeces:** Exhibitors are asked to enter the fleece competition and advise Steward if the fleece is for sale.

**Johne's Disease:** Whilst no responsibility can be taken by the Society for the actions of exhibitors in exhibiting livestock from properties without a declared health status. The Berwick A & P Society will adopt a care strategy as follows: The Sheep shed will be cleaned prior to the show and clean straw provided. It will be the responsibility of exhibitors to ensure that the laneways are kept clear of urine soaked material and faeces, and the Society will undertake the responsibility to ensure that judging areas are kept clean and tidy.

## REGULATIONS:

1. ALL ENTRIES ARE SUBJECT TO THE BY-LAW REGULATIONS OF THE SOCIETY
2. **Ovine Brucellosis:** All sheep must be from an accredited free flock or have a veterinary certificate proving a negative blood test to Ovine Brucellosis not more than 60 days prior to the Showing date. NRE Regulations will apply.
3. **Johne's Disease:** No sheep will be allowed to compete if from a property affected by, or the animal has been in contact with Johne's Disease within the past five years.
4. No sheep will be allowed to compete if infected with footrot or external parasites.
5. All sheep born after 1st January 2006 should have NLIS tags
6. All exhibitors when presenting sheep for judging must be attired smartly and appropriately. No advertising or promotional information to be displayed.
7. British Breed classes are restricted to animals bred in a registered flock and exhibited by members of the ASSBA.
8. **General:** All sheep must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor. Registered sheep and lambs must be visibly tattooed. No sheep will be allowed to compete if infected with tick.  
**Romney shearing date – May 2011.**
9. **Inspection:** All sheep shall be inspected prior to judging to see that they comply with the above conditions.
10. All Stud Sheep are restricted to animals bred in a Registered Flock and must be tattooed with their breeders registered Flock Number and the Trademark of the respective Association in accordance with the rules of that Association. Sheep not tattooed will be disqualified.

### REGULATIONS:

- All sheep entered must be the bona-fide property of a current financial member of the Black and Coloured Sheep Breeders' Association of Australia or other coloured sheep association.
- All sheep exhibited must have not more than 12 months or less than 5cm wool growth.
- Sheep entered in lamb classes must have all milk teeth in place. Lambs are not eligible for championships
- OVINE BRUCELLOSIS:** All sheep must be from an accredited free flock or have a veterinary certificate proving a negative blood test to Ovine Brucellosis not more than 60 days prior to the Showing date. **NRE Regulations will apply.**
- No sheep will be allowed to compete if infected with footrot or external parasites.
- JOHNE'S DISEASE** – no sheep will be allowed to compete if from a property affected by, or the animal has been in contact with Johne's Disease during the past five years.
- The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure sheep are entered in the correct class, otherwise sheep may be disqualified. Chief Steward is available for checking.
- Sheep may be inspected prior to judging to ensure that they comply with the above regulations.
- Judge has the right to move a sheep to a different class if they feel the sheep is entered incorrectly.
- Best Wether classes will be judged on trueness to breed and wool type

**Most Successful Exhibitor:** The Louise & Rodney Reeve Perpetual Challenge Trophy donated in perpetuity to be won by the Exhibitor gaining the highest number of points in Classes 1 to 22 inclusive. Points to be awarded – each first prize 2 points, each second prize 1 point, each Championship 1 point. Points to be calculated only when there are two or more exhibitors.
